Academic Regulations Preliminary Requirements

A student wishing to enter the School of Engineering as an undergraduate must meet a set of minimum requirements. These are posted on the School of Engineering's Web page and include specific requirements for admission as a freshman, as a transfer student, and as an international student. M.S. and Ph.D. entrance requirements are those of the Graduate School. M.S. applicants are expected to possess or be in the process of completing an undergraduate degree in engineering or closely related field from an accredited institution. In general, Ph.D. applicants are expected to possess or be in the process or be in the process of completing a master's degree.
