

Art 442: Clay and Glaze Calculation

This course focuses on understanding and experimenting with raw ceramic materials and their use in the formulation of clays and glazes. Emphasis will be placed upon proper, safe handling of materials, accurate and effective use of material and process, and the implementation of individual results. May be repeated for a maximum total of 9 hours.
