

Lat 111: Intensive Introduction to Latin

This course is an intensive introduction to Latin grammar and translation. It is the equivalent of Latin 101 and 102, and prepares students to continue to Latin 201. Students who count LAT 111 toward graduation may not also count Lat 101 or Lat 102.
