

Neu 491: Directed Study in Neuroscience I

Independent research project conducted under neuroscience faculty supervision. Requirements include a written product or an oral presentation. May be repeated once; however, a maximum of 3 hours can be applied to the neuroscience minor. As a general guideline, during regular semesters, a minimum of two hours' effort per week, per credit hour attempted, is expected.
