Acceptable freshman or sophommore-level courses are: <u>AH 101</u> , <u>AH 102</u> , <u>AH 201</u> , <u>AH 202</u> ; Music 101, Music 102, Music 103, Music 104, Music 105; Dance 200; and Theatre 201.
