### **Minor - Korean Description**

Knowledge of a foreign language is important in today's world for practical, cultural, and intellectual reasons. ### **Course Requirements**

The minor in Korean requires the completion of 15 hours of Korean courses at the 200 level or above. Kor 211 does not count towards the minor. A maximum of 9 credits for the minor may be taken through an approved study abroad program.

### **Other Academic Requirements**

Grades lower than C in modern languages courses will not be counted toward the major or minor in modern languages.
