

CSD 202: Statistics for CSD Communication Sciences & Disorders

Introduction to statistical reasoning and statistical tests used by communication sciences and disorders researchers, as well as speech- language pathologists and audiologists. The course will cover methods of measurement and techniques for summarizing sets of data. The course will stress an understanding of conceptual issues involved in the selection of statistical methods rather than memorization of formulas. Concepts will be related to everyday examples in communication sciences and disorders and related fields, as well as current events.
